Title: Natural Born Killers

Tour: Join Guest Lecturer Dr. Raymond Emmett (Daytona State College) in the field as we explore and discover a number of species of *carnivorous plants right here in central Florida! Who knows what we'll find! * Steady walkers please, as you will be walking in a park on the ground. Aficionados of plants will learn about local flora and fauna on this visit to the Central Florida Hickory Bluff Preserve. A relaxing sit-down picnic follows the trail walk.

- ✚ Carnivorous plants (like the Venus Flytrap) are plants that derive some or most of their nutrients (but not energy) from trapping and consuming animals or protozoans, typically insects and other arthropods. Carnivorous plants have adapted to grow in places where the soil is thin or poor in nutrients, especially nitrogen, such as acidic bogs and rock outcroppings
- ✚ Leisurely walking (about a half mile) – wear comfortable shoes and we'll bring bottled water.
